**S4M-13993 Graeme Pearson: Asylum for Afghan Interpreters**—That the Parliament considers that, because their work has made them a target for Taliban militants, it is unconscionable that the local interpreters who have worked with Britain's armed forces in Afghanistan have reportedly not been granted asylum by the UK Government; understands that over 200 have applied for such help and that, without this, they are effectively being abandoned, and, in light of the assistance that they provided to the armed forces, calls on the UK Government to honour what it sees as its moral, if not legal, obligation to help these people.

# Other Scottish Parliament and Government Parliamentary Question (continued)

Reply from Alex Neil: The Charities and Trustee Investment (Scotland) Act 2005 (the Act) is the statutory framework for charities operating in Scotland. The Act is reviewed regularly as part of the Scottish Government's formal and informal engagement with the Office of the Scottish Charity Regulator (OSCR). OSCR submits an annual report to Scottish Ministers and the recommendations in the report have consistently been of a minor technical nature and in the main were addressed in the Public Services Reform (Scotland) Act 2010 (part 9). Where necessary, secondary legislation has been enacted to address other matters and update the legislation. The Act provides OSCR with wide ranging and powers to make enquiries into charities and charity trustees in cases of apparent misconduct and to take remedial or protective action in relation to such misconduct. The Scottish Government wants to ensure the existing legislation and framework for self-regulation of fundraising practices is sufficient to protect public confidence and trust in charities on Scotland. We want to make sure no-one can prev on the most vulnerable people in our society and that we can continue to place our trust in our charitable sector. That is why we have asked Scottish Council for Voluntary Organisations, working with OSCR and others, to carry out an informal review to establish whether the legislation relating to fundraising in Scotland, is effectively protecting the vulnerable. The findings of the review will be reported to Scottish Ministers by the early autumn for consideration and any changes to the existing fundraising controls will be tailored to suit the needs of the people of Scotland.
