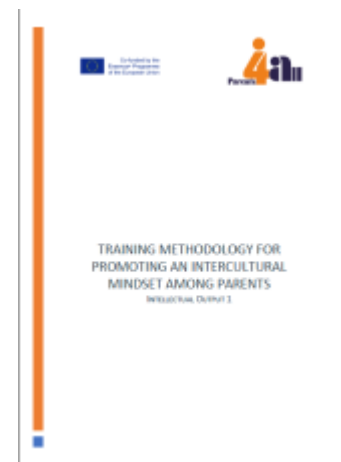

## *Project Update*

- ✓ Our Training Methodology is complete! It includes an extensive needs analysis, based on both desk research and parent input; the methodological approach to the training designed; desired learning outcomes of the course to be created; the content outline of the training course.
- ✓ The Theoretical Foundation of the Assessment Toolkit is complete. Both products are available on our project website: <http://parents4all.eu>
- ✓ Our training materials are being refined and adapted to the national contexts! We have produced 2 training units for parents from the host societies and for parents with migrant origin or from ethnic and cultural minorities (ECM). Parents will be equipped with practical information for the development of intercultural skills and a better understanding of their role in social cohesion and integration. The training material also empowers them to collaborate effectively with other parents and the school community in order to promote all children's welfare.
